


HP T520 drying time setting:


Change the drying time

You may wish to change the drying time setting to suit special printing conditions such as multiple prints where time is of higher importance or when you need to be sure ink is dry before handling.

Press  then **Printer preferences > Print retrieval > Select drying time**. You can select:

- **Extended**, to set a longer than recommended time to ensure ink is completely dry
- **Optimized**, to set the default and recommended time for your selected paper (this is the default setting)
- **None**, to disable the drying time and remove your print as soon as it finishes printing

 **CAUTION:** If the ink is not dry when the print is removed it could leave ink in the output tray and marks on the print.

 **NOTE:** If you cancel the drying time during a print, the printer may not feed and cut the paper right away due to the printhead maintenance, which runs in parallel. If the dry time is zero, the printer cuts the paper and then performs the printhead maintenance. However, if the dry time is greater than zero, the printer does not cut the paper until after the printhead maintenance has completed.
